All classes (except 1 & 2) will be run under two phase

ENTRIES CLOSE August 25th

Entries will be taken on the day if classes not already full at a cost of £1 extra. Competitors entering Class 1 **MUST** collect their numbers by 9.15am. No entries for this class will be accepted after this time. A drawn order will be displayed.

- Class 1. BEGINNERS:** Fences approx. 1'6"-1'9" Horse/pony or rider not to have won at 2'00"
- Class 2. MINI-MINIMUS:** Fences approx. 1'9"-2'00" Horse/pony or rider not to have won at 2'3"
- Class 3. MINIMUS:** Fences approx 2'3" Open to horses/ponies who have not won any money BSJA. Horse/pony/rider combination not to have come 1st with fences at 2'3" or higher
C & T Mini Qualifier.
- Class 4. NOVICE RESTRICTED:** Fences approx 2'6" Open to horse/pony/rider combination not having come 1st more than twice with fences at 2'6" or higher.
- Class 5. NOVICE OPEN :** Fences approx 2'6" Open to horses/ponies who have not won more than £10 BSJA
Chiltern & Thames Novice Qualifier
- Class 6. INTERMEDIATE :** Fences approx 2'9" Open to horses/ponies who have not won more than £50 BSJA
Chiltern & Thames Intermediate Qualifier
- Class 7. SMALL OPEN:** Fences 3'00 - 3'3". **Chiltern & Thames Open Qualifier**
- Class 8. OPEN:** Fences 3.3" - 3'6".

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Current BRC, BSJA and HHRC Standing Rules will apply.
2. Horses and ponies may not compete in more than four classes. Classes will be split if entries are sufficient into horses and ponies. Rosettes will be awarded according to the number of entries. A trophy will be awarded to the winner of each class.
3. Entry fees will only be refunded on production of a Veterinary/Doctors Certificate.
4. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, alter, amalgamate or cancel any class if necessary.
5. Everyone mounted, whether a competitor or not must wear correctly fitted protective headgear to EN1348 or PAS015, hats prefixed SE1/ASTM are acceptable (worn with a black or navy peaked cover). Failure to do so will incur a fine of £5.00.
6. Correct riding dress (light coloured jodhpurs) to be worn for all classes. No half chaps.
7. Any objections must be made in writing within 30 minutes of closing the class to the Show Secretary accompanied by a deposit of £10.00 which may be refunded.
8. **Your signature will be deemed acceptance of these rules by all persons entered on the one form.**

Rules for Shires Chiltern & Thames Showjumping Qualifiers 2010

Championships to be held at Herts County Showground on Sunday 12th September 2010.
The Showing and Show Jumping take place at the same venue on the same day.

Riders must buy their membership numbers from C & T Rider prior to the competition at a cost of £14 when purchased on line by visiting www.chilternrider.co.uk/Membership/showmembers.htm
Their numbers will be issued automatically so there is no need to wait for our office to issue a number. Alternatively riders can call the office and order their number over the phone by calling 08702 241263 at **cost of £17**. Riders cannot qualify if they do not have a membership number.

CT Rider will confirm the riders who have qualified by sending them an EMAIL and entry form for the final. They can enter on line and save £3 per entry.

Please note: Riders can only enter a maximum of 2 consecutive classes at the final e.g. Mini & Novice or Novice & Intermediate or Intermediate & Open. Horse/Pony combinations cannot enter more than two classes at the finals.

Mini Individual

- Open to horses/ponies who have **not won any money BSJA** on the date of the show at which they qualified. Also Horse & Pony combinations must not have won a class unaffiliated at this height or above before qualification to be eligible.
- Finals height 70cm first round.

Novice Individual

- Open to horses/ponies who have **not won more than £10 BSJA** on the date of the show at which they qualified.
- Finals height 80cm first round.

Intermediate Individual

- Open to horses/ponies who have **not won more than £50 BSJA** on the date of the show at which they qualified.
- Finals height 90 cm first round.

Open Individual

- Open to all horses/ponies.
- Finals height 1m first round.

There must be a minimum of 6 entries in each individual Showjumping class to make it a qualifier. All classes - First, second and third places, ponies and horses qualify. If the first and second places do not have a membership number the qualification can pass down the line as far as 5th place.

All horses and ponies must go clear in the first round to qualify.
